FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

SEPTEMBER 11, 2024

Today, September 11, 2024, President Joseph R. Biden Jr., granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania triggering the release of Federal funds to help people recover from Tropical Storm Debby that occurred August 9-10, 2024. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:
